Unlike just playing your instrument (which is hard enough), composing music demands you put your emotions, state of mind and perspective on record and present it to the world saying, "Here world. This is me. This is who I am.". And unlike an improvised solo, which is over in a flash, a composition leaves a permanent mark of who you were at the time of writing.

Compose music. This article is an introduction for anyone who wants to learn more about composing music. An introduction must be treated for that it is: a beginner's course; therefore, do not expect to learn all there is about composing.

Composing music - create melody and harmony

Music composition students receive private lessons on their main instrument and in composition, participate in small and large ensembles, take supporting courses in music technology, orchestration and arranging, counterpoint, keyboard harmony, and conducting, and complete the music core (music theory, aural skills, music history).

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
