Advent Readings for 2020 – Scripture for Lighting Wreath

As Advent wreaths began to be used by congregations on Sundays in some places in Europe and America beginning in the late 19th century, adaptations were needed for the larger worship spaces. Candles needed to be larger and more specialized than the “daily candles” handmade or purchased for home use.

Another option for this liturgy is the “Order for Lighting Advent Candles,” found in Book of Worship: United Church of Christ, pages 169–177. Rather than using the lectionary readings as a source for building the themes, that candle-lighting order draws on the themes of hope, peace, love, joy, and good news.
